We are still waiting for His answers in HIS time:

Our January letter focused on the 1,000 French Thompson Chain Reference Study Bibles we purchased for the Democratic Republic of Congo. Today, no one seems to know where those Bibles are! The freight forwarder who ships there for Samaritan's Purse is trying to find them for us. Meanwhile, the U.S. office of the ministry we were trying to help has closed for lack of funds. The DRC itself is totally shut down due to Covid-19. It is also suffering another outbreak of measles, and Ebola is back!

Questions: Where are the Bibles? How, where and when does our Father want them distributed?



Last September we purchased a large quantity of desks, chairs, tables and other items for schools in the Bahamas. That ministry never picked them up. Our warehouse is jammed. In December a ministry in Zambia said they wanted everything. The warehouse is still jammed. Zambia and most all of Africa is shut down due to Covid-19, as we are here.
