Just this week we received over 350 new Haitian Creole Bibles to add to our inventory, including highly sought after Study Bibles and Large Print Bibles. These resources are in great need in Haiti, especially considering the country's current turmoil.



Since 2018, Haiti has become more and more unstable and dangerous. You may remember hearing about the 17 missionaries who were kidnapped and held hostage in 2021, or the 3 missionaries who were killed in Haiti just last year. Unfortunately, many missionaries to Haiti have left because of the increased risk of gang violence and kidnapping. You may even know churches in your area who once sent short term mission teams to Haiti, that are no longer able to do so. However, there is still a remnant in Haiti serving the Lord in spite of the danger. We feel blessed to be able to partner with these workers to send God's word. We know that the only thing that can push back the darkness is the Light. Please continue to pray for peace in Haiti.





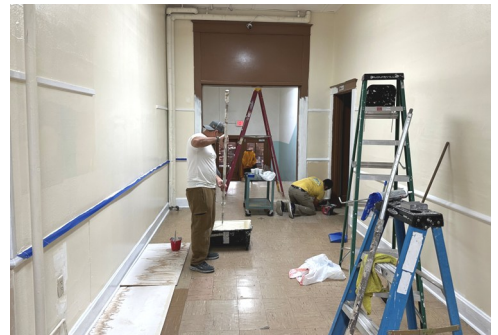
## Upcoming Ministry Trip to Togo
